

## AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, by and between THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE STATE OF KANSAS (hereinafter "Board"), Suite 520, 1000 S.W. Jackson, Topeka, Kansas 66612-1368, U.S.A. and Petra University (hereinafter "Petra"), P.O. Box 961343, Amman 11196, Jordan.

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to enter into reciprocal agreements with the governing boards of colleges and universities of other countries for purposes of and relating to the exchange of students; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are mutually desirous of entering into such an agreement with relation to students of Petra University and Emporia State University (hereinafter "ESU"); and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that it is to their mutual benefit and interest to set forth the terms of their understanding and agreement in writing;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the individual and mutual promises of the parties hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto:

1. That the term of this agreement shall begin on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2008, and terminate on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2009; provided, however, that the agreement shall continue thereafter automatically for successive one year terms, subject, however, to the right of either party at any time to terminate this agreement upon provision of written notice to the other of intent to terminate the contract within one (1) year from the date of the written notice.
2. That students who are residents of the state of Kansas shall be admitted *for study in residence at Petra* upon payment of such tuition or fees applicable to residents of Jordan.
3. That students who are residents of Petra shall be admitted *for study in residence at ESU* upon payment of such tuition or fees applicable to residents of Kansas.
4. That students shall always be exchanged on a reciprocal basis and the number of students exchanged must be approved by both institutional presidents.
5. That each institution shall advise the other of the academic requirements for admission to any program, department, school or college in which students will be exchanged.
6. That each institution shall be responsible for any academic credit to be awarded to its students *in residence*.
7. That each institution will require participating students to maintain their own medical/health insurance to provide coverage while participating in a student exchange.
