It is the ideal setting for interior décor that exudes a sense of oriental luxury and leisure. **Photo top right, Flap, designed by Francesco Binfaré for Edra:** Not a straight line or right angle in sight, Flap will sensationally accommodate any slumber position you desire: Backwards, frontwards, left over, right over, sitting, lounging, reading, watching or just plain collapsed. The painted steel table can be attached horizontally to a second table or attached vertically to create a two-shelf arrangement.
