that follow these guidelines can reduce the Vehicle Miles Travelled [VMT] by as much as 10 percent [Allen, 16].)

- 14. Make public spaces the focus of building orientation and neighborhood activity. Move large car parks away from streets and screen them with buildings.
- 15. Use compact building designs and layouts to minimize consumption of land and conserve natural

resources. *Maintain and restore environmental attributes of development sites* (Porter, 2000: p. 2).

- 16. Design buildings to reduce the consumption of energy and non-renewable resources and the production of waste and pollution (Porter, 2000: p. 2).
