


4.12 Restaurants



The indirect general lighting in the entrance and seating area is provided by wall-washers. A regular arrangement of double-focus downlights provide direct light throughout the main restaurant area. A supplementary row of directional spotlights illuminate the plants between the seated area and the bar. The bar is accentuated by a series of downlights that follow the shape of the bar.

Recessed downlight for low-voltage halogen lamps.


















Recessed double-focus downlight for lowvoltage halogen lamps.





Indirect general lighting is provided by ceiling washlights arranged along the side walls. A staggered layout of decorative recessed downlights provides accent lighting on the tables and bar. Trackmounted spotlights illuminate the plants and entrance area.


Wall-mounted ceiling washlight for halogen lamps or general service lamps.
