In a study of design protocols already referred to in Chapters 3 and 6, Rowe's analysis led him to describe the design emerging through the use of several parallel primary generators:

In this case study, several distinct lines of reasoning can be identified, often involving the a priori use of an organising principle or model to direct the decision-making process.
