

those ideas which are compatible with sustainable development. Chapter 6 covers the techniques used in evaluating alternative proposals. Project evaluation for major urban design projects which aim at delivering sustainable development and therefore at the promotion of equity should include a consideration of the distribution of costs and benefits: the gainers and losers should be clearly identified. This chapter therefore covers social and economic evaluation such as cost-benefit analysis in addition to environmental analysis. Chapter 7 is concerned with communication of ideas; it includes techniques of report presentation and case studies in visual presentation of urban design projects. Chapter 8 discusses the process of implementation, summarizing the whole process of design using project management as a means of relating the construction phase, monitoring and feedback to the earlier phases of design method. Chapter 9 is a short conclusion summarizing the contents of the chapters and raising a number of questions left unanswered in the text.

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
