[O Muhammad] Call to the way of your Lord using wisdom and kind advice and enter into positive dialogue [with those of other religions]. For your Lord knows best who has gone astray and who is rightly guided in His path.

If you must punish your enemy, then punish only to the extent that you yourself have been offended – but it is much better to practice restraint instead. Remain steadfast, for you can do this only with God's help.

Do not feel sad about nonbelievers, or worry over what they plot against you, for God is surely with those who have piety and who work to perfect their good deeds.
