## Bismillahir-Rahmanir-Raheem

- Exalt the name of your Lord, the Most High.
- Who created and proportioned 2..
- 3 And who destined and [then] guided
- 4. And who brings out the pasture
- And [then] makes it black stubble. 5.
- 6. We will make you recite, [O Muhammad], and you will not forget,
- 7. Except what Allah should will. Indeed, He knows what is declared and what is hidden
- And We will ease you toward ease. 1777 8.
- So remind, if the reminder should benefit; 1778 9.
- He who fears [Allāh] will be reminded. 10
- 11 But the wretched one will avoid it -

- 1. Has there reached you the report of the Overwhelming [event]?
- 2. [Some] faces, that Day, will be humbled,
- Working [hard] and exhausted. 1780
- 4. They will [enter to] burn in an intensely hot Fire.
- 5. They will be given drink from a boiling spring.
- For them there will be no food except from a poisonous, thorny plant
- 7. Which neither nourishes nor avails against hunger.
- 8. [Other] faces, that Day, will show pleasure.
- 9. With their effort [they are] satisfied
- 10. In an elevated garden,
- 11. Wherein they will hear no unsuitable speech. 1781
- 12. Within it is a flowing spring.
- 13. Within it are couches raised high
- 14. And cups put in place
- 15. And cushions lined up
- 16. And carpets spread around.
- 17. Then do they not look at the camels how they are created?
- 18. And at the sky how it is raised?
- 19. And at the mountains how they are erected?
