- 23. However, he who turns away and disbelieves -
- 24. Then Allāh will punish him with the greatest punishment.
- 25. Indeed, to Us is their return.
- 26. Then indeed, upon Us is their account.

## Bismillāhir-Rahmānir-Raheem

- 1. By the dawn
- 2. And [by] ten nights<sup>1783</sup>
- 3. And [by] the even [number] and the odd
- 4. And [by] the night when it passes.
- 5 Is there [not] in [all] that an oath [sufficient] for one of perception?1784
- Have you not considered how your Lord dealt with 'Aad -6.
- [With] Iram<sup>1785</sup> who had lofty pillars,<sup>1786</sup> 7
- The likes of whom had never been created in the land? 8
- 9. And [with] Thamūd, who carved out the rocks in the valley?
- 10. And [with] Pharaoh, owner of the stakes?<sup>1787</sup> –
- 11. [All of] whom oppressed within the lands
- 12 And increased therein the corruption.
- 13 So your Lord poured upon them a scourge of punishment.
- 14 Indeed, your Lord is in observation.
- And as for man, when his Lord tries him and [thus] is generous 15. to him and favors him, he says, "My Lord has honored me."1788
