1. Competition in [worldly] increase diverts you
2. Until you visit the graveyards.¹⁸⁴⁹
3. No! You are going to know.
4. Then, no! You are going to know.
5. No! If you only knew with knowledge of certainty...¹⁸⁵⁰
6. You will surely see the Hellfire.
7. Then you will surely see it with the eye of certainty.¹⁸⁵¹
8. Then you will surely be asked that Day about pleasure.¹⁸⁵²
