

*Sūrah al-Kawthar*<sup>1870</sup>*Bismillāhir-Raḥmānir-Raḥeem*

1. Indeed, We have granted you, [O Muḥammad], al-Kawthar.
2. So pray to your Lord and sacrifice [to Him alone].
3. Indeed, your enemy is the one cut off.<sup>1871</sup>

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<sup>1870</sup>*Al-Kawthar*: Literally, "the most abundant good." Also, a river in Paradise.

<sup>1871</sup>From all good in this world and the Hereafter.

**Sūrah al-Kāfirūn**<sup>1872</sup>***Bismillāhir-Raḥmānir-Raḥeem***

1. Say, "O disbelievers,
2. I do not worship what you worship.
3. Nor are you worshippers of what I worship.
4. Nor will I be a worshipper of what you worship.
5. Nor will you be worshippers of what I worship.
6. For you is your religion, and for me is my religion."

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<sup>1872</sup> *Al-Kāfirūn*: The Disbelievers. The Prophet (ﷺ) mentioned that this *sūrah* is disassociation from *shirk* (worship of anything other than Allāh) for him who recites it. (Narrated by Aḥmad, Abū Dāwūd and at-Tirmidhī – *ḥasan*.)
