## Social networking tools

Partly because blogging is a form of networking and partly because a lot of blogging is being done by Web innovators, many bloggers are heavily involved with social networks, such as LinkedIn, Audioscrobbler, and Friendster.

What these sites aim to do is better connect you with your current group of friends or colleagues and to build relationships between those with similar interests. Sound a little like the network of relationships inherent to blogs and blogging? It should! Being a member of these communities has intangible benefits but definitely demonstrates an understanding of Internet trends and technologies that only speaks well of you. Additionally, your accessibility through these mediums encourages curious bloggers and readers to get in touch directly. And, of course, getting hooked into the conversations going on within these networks can generate buzz and readership for your blog.

Not all of these networks are useful to you, but think creatively about how you can leverage these networks to add value and functionality to your business blog.

## Audioscrobbler

Audioscrobbler (www.audioscrobbler.com) collects information about the music you listen to and then matches your musical tastes with that of other users. The result is a list of recommended music and contacts with whom you can talk in forums and form into groups (see Figure 8-5).
