Glenn Reynolds is a law professor at the University of Tennessee and the prominent blogger behind InstaPundit, shown in Figure 18-3. Reynolds also writes a column that looks an awful lot like a blog for MSNBC. Reynolds blogs about politics on the right, law issues, the presidency, and anything else that strikes his fancy.

In his FAQ, Reynolds warns readers that InstaPundit is a hobby, not a news site, and admits that he can't explain the blog's popularity: "Other than e-mailing a few journalist-types early on, I've done nothing to promote InstaPundit; it's all been a function of links and word-of-mouth. Well, word-of-e-mail, anyway. It's just the magic of the Internet." Reynolds started InstaPundit in August 2001.

Unlike most bloggers, Reynolds does not allow readers to post comments on his site.
