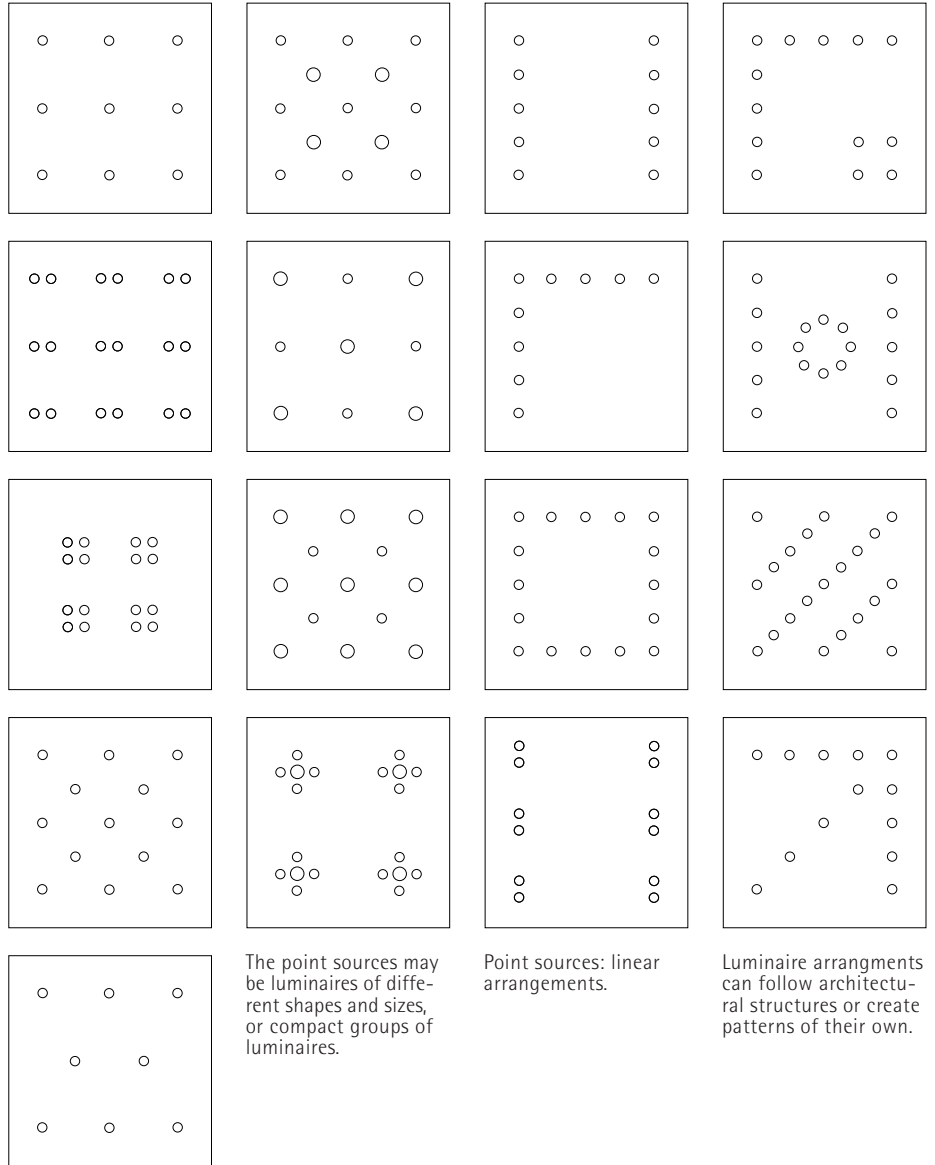


Linear arrangement of ceiling luminaires follows the length of the long walls. The end wall is illuminated separately, by a linear arrangement of recessed floor luminaires.

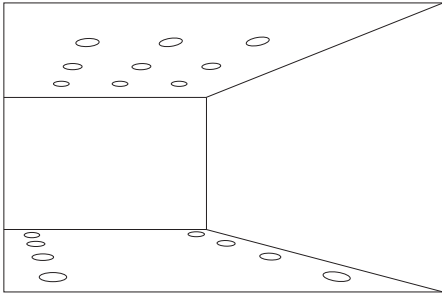


Point sources: regular and staggered layouts.

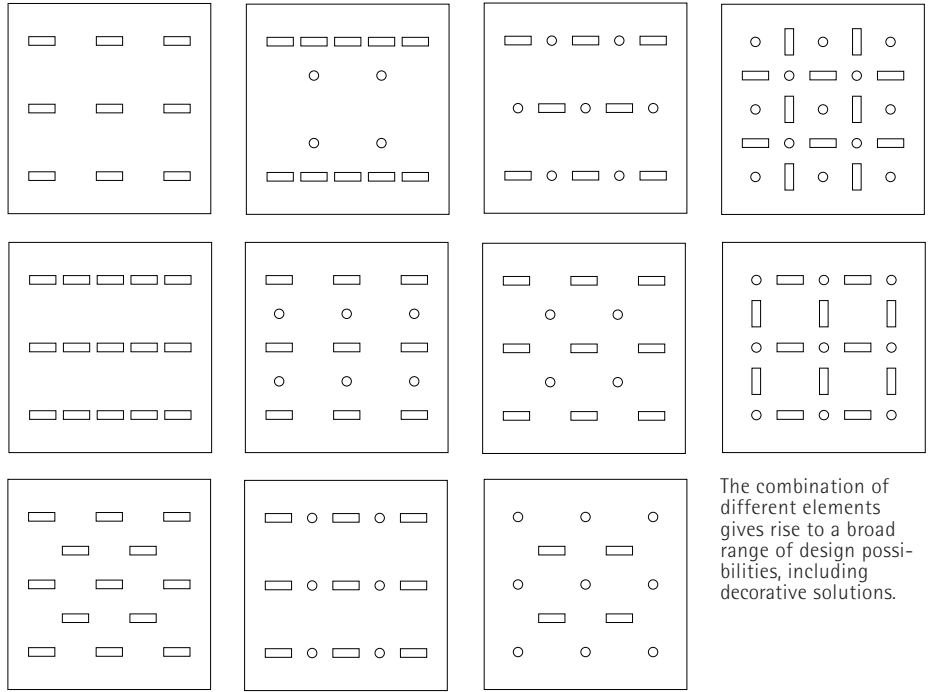
The point sources may be luminaires of different shapes and sizes, or compact groups of luminaires.

Luminaire arrangements can follow architectural structures or create patterns of their own.

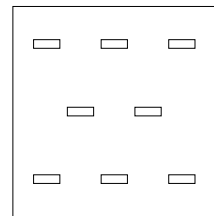


A regular arrangement of ceiling luminaires provides the ambient lighting in the space. The long walls are accentuated separately by recessed floor luminaires.

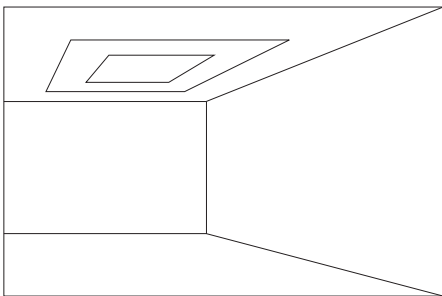


The combination of different elements gives rise to a broad range of design possibilities, including decorative solutions.

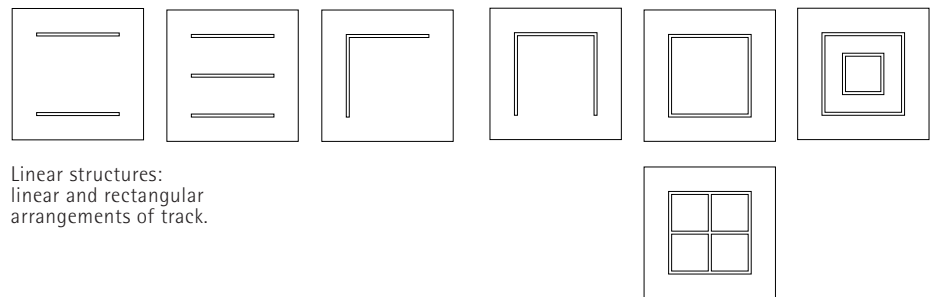
Linear and point elements: regular and staggered arrangements.
